Make popcorn, talk about what you hear, see, smell and taste



Rake leaves and jump in them; talk about what you will do

While riding in the car, label places that you pass like the gas station, grocery store, church, etc.



Find 4 things that are green, label them

Talk about opposites: big/little empty/full tall/short

Look at pictures of animals and talk about their body parts



Play "I Spy" describing what you see

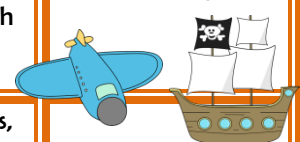


Look at various kitchen utensils (whisk, spatula, etc.) label them and talk about their use

Using blocks or boxes, make "buildings" talk about tall/short

Make and/or decorate cookies, talk about what you need for each step

Trace your hand and make it into a turkey; talk about each step



Name as many different types of drinks as you can think of

When eating dinner, compare what everyone is eating using words like more and less

Play hide and seek, talk about where everyone hid using prepositions: behind, under, next to, etc.

Collect fall leaves, look at moogcenter.org for language ideas

Talk about four things you can ride in



Using toys make a pattern, *i.e., car, block, car, block, car, block* talk about "What comes next?"

Make chocolate milk, talk about what you will do first, second, third, etc.

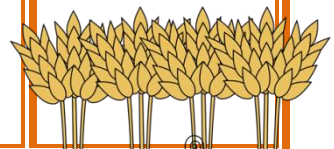
Go outside, talk about the changes you see in fall
